## **Court of The Human Beings – Central Registration Office (ZMA)** **Definition and functional description of the Central Intelligent Agency (CIA)**

### **1. Conceptual classification**

CHB - GdM , the designation CIA (Central Intelligent Agency) does not refer to an intelligence organization, but to a central, public, intelligent, humanitarian data and information authority for international civil protection.

It serves the purpose of collecting, processing, and transferring data of protected civilians in accordance with Articles 132–149 of the Fourth Geneva Convention. The term "intelligent" describes the technical capability for the structured, secure, and data protection-compliant management of humanitarian information within the systematic legal framework of international law.

### **2. Legal basis**

The legal basis of the Central Intelligent Agency (CIA) within the framework of the ZMA is Article 140 of the Fourth Geneva Convention of 12 August 1949 in conjunction with Articles 1–12, 132–149 GA IV, Article 73 UN Charter, Article 6 EGBGB, Article 17 GDPR and Articles 3, 32, 41 and 56 of 56/83 UN RES for the right of the person being released with determination of the choice of law in international law.

These provisions guarantee the protection, registration and information processing of protected civilians while respecting the international public legal order (ordre public).

### **3. Tasks of the Central Intelligent Agency (CIA) in Civil Protection**

- Central coordination of all humanitarian data collection and communication between protecting powers, states and international organizations.
- Storage and management of protection status data (civilians, internally displaced persons, war victims, family members) in accordance with the provisions of the Geneva Convention IV.
- Humanitarian communication with courts, authorities and protection bodies, in particular the CHB- GdM as a court of retaliation and restitution within the meaning of Articles 147–149 of the Geneva Convention IV.
- Safeguarding data security, human dignity and confidentiality obligations pursuant to Art. 17 GDPR and Art. 32 KSÜ as well as the obligation to choose jurisdiction under international law (§ 20 (2) GVG).
- Support of the protecting power functions and the administration of international justice through intelligent database data processing, statistical evaluation and documentation of international legal processes and nitrification of war crimes and victims of war crimes.
